

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION TWO FORMS OF GOVERNMENT ISSUE ID ARE REQUIRED

YOU MUST BRING AT LEAST TWO OF THE FOLLOWING GOVERNMENT ISSUED IDs

- Driver License: must have photograph, must be current and must display a person's name, address and signature.
- State/County Issued Identification Card with photograph. Expired School IDs are not valid.
- Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) Documents – Must be original, valid and must contain a photograph.
- Military Identification with photograph.
- Alien Registration Card with photograph.
- Valid Passport with a recent photograph if Non-US issued requires accompanying letter from Embassy on Embassy Letterhead, written in English, verifying authenticity of the Passport, with that Official's signature and contact information.
- Citizenship Papers with photograph.
- Social Security Card (SSN), Social Insurance Card(SIN), Taxpayer ID Card (TID), Deferred Action Card (DAC), Social Security verification letter
- Foreign Passport with School IDs are usually invalid unless, they are current as in they were issued for the current school year or in the summer, the prior year.
- State or Federal Program Issued ID cards i.e. Job Corp, NJ Youth Challenge

THE ITEMS MUST, BETWEEN THE TWO, CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING:

Current Photo
Current Address (to show NJ residency)
Signature
Identification number (SSN, SIN, TID, DAC, or SS Administration Verification letter.)
Date of Birth

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE TWO OF THE ACCEPTED FORMS OF ID: contact the DMV to either obtain a driver's license or ID card and/ or contact a passport office.

IF YOU HAVE TWO FORMS OF ID BUT DO NOT HAVE ANYTHING THAT LISTS YOUR CURRENT ADDRESS, THE FOLLOWING ARE ACCEPTABLE TO VERIFY YOUR NJ RESIDENCY IN ADDITION TO THE TWO PRIMARY IDs.

For Address:

- Utility bill, bank statement, lease, automotive registration, or automotive insurance ID that shows your name and your New Jersey address
- Credit Card statement with NJ address
- Employer Identification Card with photograph with NJ address
- Health Insurance Card with NJ address
