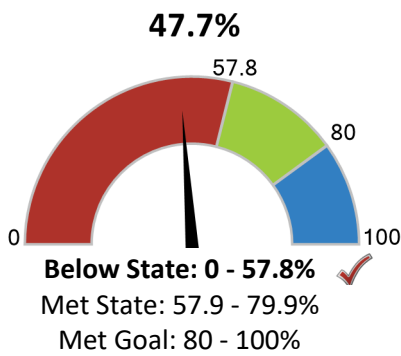
## School Highlights Reported by the District

- Students can earn an associate's degree before graduating high school. Seventeen students in the graduating class of 2020 will receive their associate's degree before they graduate high school

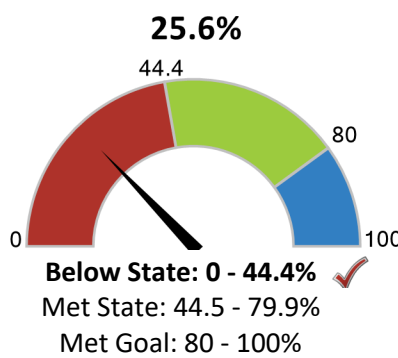
### How did students perform on assessments?

#### English Language Arts



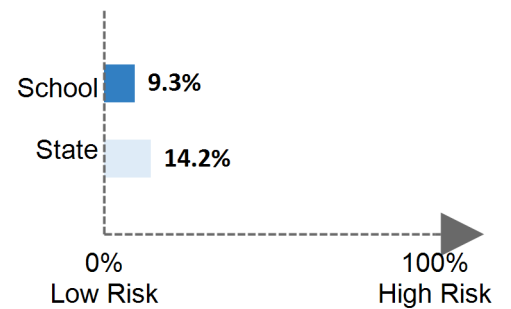
#### Math

Students that were absent for 10% or more of days enrolled

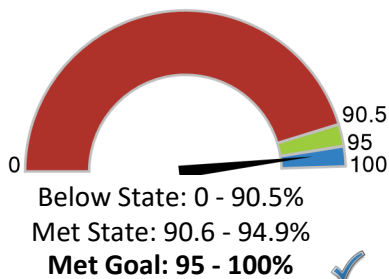
#### Chronic Absenteeism
