What services are available?

In accordance with the *Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)* Title IA funding, supplemental services for Mathematics and Language Arts are available at SCVTS.

Who is eligible for services?

All students are eligible to receive support in both Mathematics and English Language Arts course content. Data and monitoring are used to determine student academic deficiencies and effectiveness of interventions.

What services are available?

With approval, eligible students will receive supplemental services through a combination of instructional delivery methods, including:

- Pull-Out Program
 - Students will be provided small class/group instruction designed to meet their individual learning plan goals

- In Class Support
 - Students will receive additional in class support within their chosen Career and Technical program by a qualified instructor designed to assist with mastering skills and standards
- Tutoring
 - Students can request tutoring before or after school with a content-certified instructor that will focus on English Language Arts and Mathematics skills.
